Declaration of Intent

between

**The Danish Ministry of the Environment,
The United Nations Industrial Development Organization,
and Carlsberg Breweries A/S**

**to support the advancement of environmentally sustainable solutions
in the Russian Federation**

Whereas Carlsberg Breweries A/S and the United Nations Industrial Development Organisation concluded a Memorandum of Understanding on 9 October 2012, by which they formed a public-private-partnership (hereinafter "*the partnership*") with the aim of cooperating closely and consulting one another on matters of mutual interest in order to achieve their common objective to advance environmentally sustainable solutions,

Whereas the objective of the said partnership can be accomplished, inter alia, by demonstrating a replicable approach to public private partnerships in support of resource efficient cleaner production and sustainable natural resource management along the entire supply chain,

Now therefore, the Danish Ministry of the Environment, represented by the Minister for the Environment, Ms Ida Auken; the United Nations Industrial Development Organization, represented by Mr. Sergey Korotkov; Carlsberg Breweries A/S, represented by the President of Baltika Breweries and Senior Vice President of Carlsberg Group, Dr Isaac Sheps, (hereinafter referred to as "*the parties*"), declare as follows:

1. The parties hereby express their support for the objectives of the above partnership between UNIDO and Carlsberg Breweries in order to advance environmentally sustainable solutions in the Russian Federation.
2. The parties welcome and support this partnership as an effective mechanism to advance environmentally sustainable solutions and to create replicable approaches on how economic growth can go hand-in-hand with benefits for the environment and natural resource consumption.

3. The parties recognise the nature of the partnership and in particular the importance of the international expertise brought to the partnership by UNIDO as a specialized agency of the United Nations with primary responsibility in promoting sustainable industrial development.
4. The parties may wish to consult from time to time with a view to exchanging views on good practise and relevant expertise.
5. Carlsberg Breweries and UNIDO welcome the support for the objectives of the partnership, and underline the substantial economic and in-kind investments that will need to be made by the partnership to advance environmentally sustainable solutions.
6. The Danish Ministry will offer to contribute relevant Danish expertise to activities under the partnership when deemed useful by all parties. This expertise could include Danish experience with efficient handling of returnable glass bottles, water efficiency and treatment of water and waste material as potential un-tapped resources.
